Dear Louisiana Tumor Registrar:

Thank you for your interest in the NAACCR Cancer Registry webinars. The Louisiana Tumor Registry (LTR) is pleased to be able to provide access to recorded versions of these at no cost to registrars within our state. We've found these to be valuable educational tools which provide comprehensive training, particularly for those webinars that are disease-specific, since information on anatomy, histology, Collaborative Stage coding, multiple primary/histology coding, and coding of treatment data is contained within. Exercises, answers, quizzes, and questions and answers are also included. NCRA CE credits (3 - 4 per webinar) are available.

If you are interested in viewing the recorded version of a webinar, please complete the *first* attached form and return it to LTR, indicating which of the available webinar(s) you are interested in viewing. Please note that in order for LTR to release the access information, you must agree to the confidentiality agreement set forth by NAACCR (excerpted below), which LTR supports. A signature is required and the form can be faxed, scanned and e-mailed, or mailed to LTR.

After viewing the webinar(s), in order to obtain continuing education (CE) credits acceptable by NCRA, documentation of completion is required. This can be done in the form of a manager's signature or a personal signature. Once the session(s) has been viewed, please sign the *second* attached form and return it to LTR. The form can be faxed, scanned and e-mailed, or mailed to LTR. The CE credit information will then be released.

To view the webinar, you will need a computer, an internet connection, and speakers. You may need a projector depending on the number of persons viewing the webinar. Please keep in mind that each session is three to four hours long, but the recorded version can be stopped at any point, allowing the webinar to be viewed over the course of a few days. Breaks can also be scheduled, or the recording can be stopped to discuss important coding points. The exercises are very helpful and should be completed before viewing the webinar.

Once again, thank you for your interest in the webinars and we hope you find them to be educationally rewarding as well as enjoyable.

Terms of Use Agreement

By taking possession of a video recording, in digital format, of a “webinar” session (henceforth known as the “media file”) previously hosted by NAACCR, Inc., the party receiving the media file (henceforth known as “purchaser”) either by download, transfer, or by means of recordable media, is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement. Those terms and conditions are as follows:

- (1) The media file may only be distributed to employees within the purchaser’s organization or to employees of entities that are required to submit information to the purchaser’s organization as required by law (for example: hospitals that must submit data to a central registry).
- (2) The distribution of the media file is limited to specific forms of only; these forms are as follows:
 - a. Posting to an internal intranet that is accessible only by those described in (1).
 - b. By electronic mail sent only to persons described in (1).
 - c. Posting to a private (username and password protected) FTP site, accessible only by persons described in (1).
 - d. Transfer of recordable media (such as floppy disks or writable/re-writable CDs or DVDs) to persons described in (1).
- (3) The media file may **not** be distributed by other means; these include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Posting to an external website.
 - b. Posting to a public FTP site.
 - c. Distribution on recordable media to persons other than those described in (1).
 - d. Transfer via electronic mail to persons other than those described in (1).

The media file and its contents are the sole intellectual property of NAACCR, Inc. Transfer of possession does not denote transfer of ownership.
