

#### **Defining the Need**



- § 898,946 Louisianans live in poverty
- 798,330 are food insecure.
- 393,620 are food insecure in SHFB 23-parish service area alone

#### Who we serve

- 42% are working households
- 28% are children under 18
- 20% are senior citizens
- 69% have a high school diploma or GED credential
- 23% have a post-high school education
- § 97% are NOT homeless

Many with low incomes are forced to choose between food for themselves and their families and other vital expenses:



#### Meals for the community

- 34 million meals provided across a 23-parish service area in FY 17
- We provide more than 34,000,000 pounds of food each year to more than 210,000 people through our community partner network:
  - **♦** Food pantries
  - ♦ Soup kitchens
  - **♦ Shelters**
  - **♦ Schools**

- Educate, inform, and uplift the voices of the workers




#### Methods

- Analysis of Data Collected















#### Challenges

- Gaining the trust of workers in a short period of time






