- LSUHSC-NO Libraries Announce Transformative Publishing Agreements with Elsevier, RSNA, and ACS:

#### Elsevier Agreement:

The three-year partnership with Elsevier covers APCs for a limited number of articles in over 1,800 hybrid journals. Until patterns are established and analyzed, the Libraries will approve APC waivers on first-come, first-served basis until all slots are filled.

#### **RSNA Agreement**:

The two-year, cost-neutral agreement with the Radiological Society of North America eliminates APC fees for unlimited articles in Radiology, Radio Graphics, Radiology: Artificial Intelligence, Radiology: Cardiothoracic Imaging, and Radiology: Imaging Cancer.

#### **ACS Agreement**:

This new partnership with the American Chemical Society secures unlimited APC-free publication of articles in the 70 ACS hybrid journals, as well as open access titles such as ACS Central Science, ACS Omega, Artificial Photosynthesis, Chem & Bio Engineering, Chemical & Biomedical Imaging, Environment & Health, Photon Science, Polymer Science & Technology, Precision Chemistry, and the ACS Au journals.
