Dr. Sandro Galea is a physician, epidemiologist, and author who currently serves as the Margaret C. Ryan Dean of the School of Public Health at Washington University in St. Louis. He previously held major leadership roles at the Boston University School of Public Health, the Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health, the University of Michigan School of Public Health, and the New York Academy of Medicine.

An internationally recognized scholar, Dr. Galea has published more than 750 scientific articles, 50 book chapters, and 13 books on topics spanning population health, trauma, mental health, and health equity. His work has been widely featured in national and international media outlets, and he is known for advancing the understanding of how social, economic, and environmental forces shape public health.
