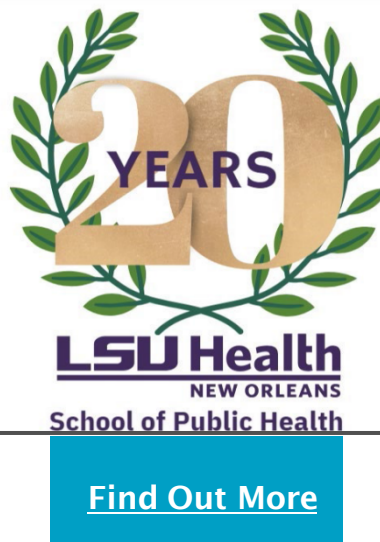

- **Measuring Prescription Opioid Use Using Medicare Part D Claims Data in SEER-MHOS Research Projects** **will be held on Tuesday, June 24, 2025, from 1:00 to 2:00 PM ET**. This event focuses on approaches to measuring prescription opioid use in SEER-MHOS studies. It will highlight how Medicare Part D claims data linked at the patient level can support analyses of opioid prescribing practices, pain management, and the epidemiology of pain. The webinar will cover methods for identifying and classifying prescription opioids, constructing measures such as days' supply and morphine milligram equivalents, selecting appropriate measurement timeframes, and recognizing common limitations in using pharmacy claims data.
