- NIH is implementing consistent and robust protocols to ensure NIH controlled-access data are appropriately safeguarded (<u>NOT-OD-25-</u> 159).
- NIH has received OMB approval under the Paperwork Reduction Act
  (PRA) to collect information through the NIH Certificate of
  Confidentiality (CoC) system. NIH is now accepting requests in the
  CoC System for Research Not Funded by NIH and Institutional Official
  verifications.

NIH will no longer post NOFOs in the NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts. The NIH Guide will continue as your primary source for policy and informational notices.
